

COVID-19: HOW WE CONTINUE TO ENSURE YOUR SAFETY

TRACKDAYS AND TESTING

England progressed to Step 4 on the government's roadmap on Monday 19 July, with the removal of almost all legal restrictions.

From this date onwards, the current restrictions on the use of garages and the number of people that can attend will be dropped. Spectators will also be permitted, whilst being discouraged from entering any working areas of the venue.

Whilst motor racing circuits are outdoor venues we recognise the importance of maintaining sensible precautions to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission. These are detailed below:

- You should not attend a trackday or test day if you have tested positive for COVID-19 or you are legally required to self-isolate. If this applies, contact your event organiser as soon as possible
- If you develop COVID-19 symptoms whilst participating in an event, or you are contacted by NHS Test and Trace and informed you need to self-isolate, you should leave the venue immediately and avoid any close contact with others
- Event registration will continue to be completed online in advance
- All buildings will be adequately ventilated to ensure fresh air flow in enclosed spaces
- We will deploy enhanced cleaning, particularly on shared equipment and surfaces that people touch regularly
- Hand sanitiser will be readily available across all our venues
- We recommend the use of face coverings in enclosed indoor spaces. Please ensure you bring one with you to the event
- Face coverings will be required for in-car instruction and ARDS tests if using an open face helmet
- We will provide NHS QR code posters to enable visitors to check-in when they arrive at our venues
- MSV staff who work indoors may be based behind Perspex screens or wear appropriate PPE
